ENZI HIGHLIGHTS U.S. JOB CREATION DURING MARCH

Washington, D.C. – U.S. Senator Mike Enzi, R-Wyo., Chairman of the Senate Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (HELP) Committee, praised the state of America’s growing economy and made the following statement on the positive job creation numbers released today by the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS):

“I’m pleased to see that 211,000 Americans were able to join the world’s best workforce last month, resulting in a decrease of the national unemployment rate to 4.7%. Today’s announcement reflects a strong economy that is continuing to grow across the entire country. I promise to continue to work on legislation that will keep money in the hands of our nation’s businesses, workers, and families, not in the hands of bureaucrats in Washington, D.C.”
