***ENZI: AMERICAN ECONOMY CONTINUES TO GROW,  
CREATE BETTER-PAYING JOBS***

**Washington, D.C.** – The American economy is continuing to “grow and create new, better-paying jobs under pro-growth policies,” U.S. Senator Mike Enzi (R-Wyo.), Chairman of the Senate Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (HELP) Committee, said today, praising a report from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) showing that the American economy created 132,000 new jobs in November.

“Today’s announcement is proof positive that the economy is continuing on the right track,” Enzi said. “The American people have shown once again that they can spend their hard-earned money better than the Federal government can, so we must continue to pursue a pro-growth policy approach that keeps more money in their wallets.

“By continuing to ease the tax burden on America’s working families and controlling government spending, we will further spur economic growth and lower the deficit.”

Enzi noted that under Republican leadership, the U.S. economy has created 7 million new jobs since August 2003 – more than every other industrialized nation combined. November marked the 39<sup>th</sup> consecutive month of job creation. The economy has grown 3 percent over the last year, which saw a 2.8 percent jump in real wages.
