STATEMENT BY SENATOR EDWARD M. KENNEDY ON HOUSE STEM CELL VICTORY

Washington, D.C. – Today, Senator Edward M. Kennedy released the following statement on the U.S. House vote to pass life saving stem cell legislation:

“Today’s vote is a victory for hope and the enormous promise that embryonic stem cell research has in the fight against disease. We are now one step closer to the possibility of a fuller, longer life for millions and millions of people who suffer. I look forward to the Senate considering this bill, and anticipate broad bipartisan support for this enormously promising research. And I urge the President to reconsider his position on one of the great breakthroughs of modern medicine.”
