## **Enzi: By any measure, Reid bill a failure**

**Washington, D.C.** – U.S. Senator Mike Enzi (R-Wyo.) today made the following remarks as the Senate moved closer to a critical vote on whether to move forward on the Reid health care bill:

“The Majority Leader has jammed ten pounds of entitlement spending into a five pound sack. But he is not fooling the American people. The voices of August are still echoing and coming from a vast majority,” Enzi said.

“We need health care reform to ensure quality, affordable care for all Americans. Unfortunately, the Reid bill would increase health care costs, do nothing to improve the quality of care, and threaten our nation’s jobs and economic growth.

“Where’s the quality? Where’s the affordability? What happened to covering everybody? By any measure, the Reid bill is a failure.

“I hope to defeat this bill so that we can move forward to work on real, bipartisan health care reform,” Enzi said.
