## A BILL

To preclude the Department of Labor from allowing the Deputy Secretary to serve as the Secretary of Labor indefinitely.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Advice and Consent
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR VACANCIES.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1 of the Act of April 17,
- 8 1946 (60 Stat. 91; 29 U.S.C. 552) is amended by adding
- 9 at the end the following: "Notwithstanding the previous
- 10 sentence or any other provision of law, if the Deputy Sec-
