5 (a) DATA ON FEDERAL TAX CREDIT VOUCHER.—In

6 carrying out the duties described in section 154 of the

7 Education Sciences Reform Act of 2002 (20 U.S.C. 9544),

8 the Statistics Commissioner shall collect and report data

9 on eligible students who receive a scholarship from a schol-

10 arship granting organization, including—

- 1 (1) annual family income;
- 2 (2) demographics of eligible students;
- 3 (3) eligible student enrollment and attendance;
- 4 (4) scholarship award amount received and ac-
- 5 tivities funded for the duration of the school year;
- 6 (5) eligible student academic achievement; and
- 7 (6) what type of educational setting such eligi-
- 8 ble student attended in the prior school year.

9 (b) BIENNIAL REPORT.—Not later than 2 full fiscal
10 years after the date of enactment of this Act, the Director
11 of the Institute of Education Science shall submit to the
12 Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions
13 and the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate and
14 the Committee on Education and Workforce and the Com-
15 mittee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives,
16 and make public in a format that is widely accessible and
17 publicly available, a report containing the information de-
18 scribed in subsection (a).

19 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the terms “eligi-
20 ble student” and “scholarship granting organization” have
21 the meanings given the terms in section 25F of the Inter-
22 nal Revenue Code of 1986.
