4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the terms “eligi-  
5 ble student”, “scholarship granting organization”, and  
6 “qualified contribution” have the meanings given such  
7 terms in section 25F of the Internal Revenue Code of  
8 1986.

9 (b) SCHOOLS SUBJECT TO FEDERAL CIVIL RIGHTS  
10 LAWS.—Any school that enrolls an eligible student who

1 receives a scholarship from a scholarship granting organi-  
2 zation that distributes qualified contributions shall be sub-  
3 ject to—

4 (1) titles IV and VI of the Civil Rights Act of  
5 1964 (42 U.S.C. 2000c et seq. and 2000d et seq.);

6 (2) title IX of the Education Amendments of  
7 1972 (20 U.S.C. 1681 et seq.);

8 (3) the Individuals with Disabilities Education  
9 Act (20 U.S.C. 1400 et seq.);

10 (4) title II of the Americans with Disabilities  
11 Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12131 et seq.);

12 (5) section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of  
13 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794); and

14 (6) the Equal Educational Opportunities Act of  
15 1974 (20 U.S.C. 1701 et seq.).
