2 **SEC. __. INSPECTOR GENERAL REPORT.**

3 By not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
4 of this Act, the Inspector General of the Department of
5 Education shall—

6 (1) perform an audit on the Office for Civil
7 Rights of the Department of Education to identify

1 the capacity of the Office to carry out its mission;
2 and

3 (2) submit the results of the completed audit,
4 along with any findings or recommendations of the
5 Inspector General, to the Committee on Health,
6 Education, Labor, and Pensions of the Senate and
7 the Committee on Education and Workforce of the
8 House of Representatives.
