2 **SEC. 6. PROHIBITION ON DOGE INVOLVEMENT AT THE OF-**

3 **FICE FOR CIVIL RIGHTS.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-

5 eral funds may be appropriated or transferred to, or used

6 by, the Department of Government Efficiency to access

7 any information maintained by the Office for Civil Rights

8 at the Department of Education, including—

1           (1) such information maintained for policy de-  
2           velopment or civil rights enforcement; and

3           (2) any data related to complaints, open cases  
4           or investigations, and Office for Civil Rights staff  
5           attorneys involved in civil rights enforcement.
