4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

5 (1) COVERED INSTITUTION.—The term "cov-6 ered institution" means a college, university, or 7 other postsecondary institution, or a public system 8 of higher education that receives Federal funds.

9 (2) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
10 the Secretary of Education.

(b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con gress that the Department of Education should expedi tiously issue a proposed rule pursuant to Executive Order
 13899 (84 Fed. Reg. 68779; relating to Combating Anti Semitism).

6 (c) OCR DESIGNEE.—Not later than 180 days after 7 the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall des-8 ignate a senior officer or senior employee of the Office for 9 Civil Rights (in this section referred to as the "Des-10 ignee"). The Designee shall—

(1) serve as the Secretary's primary advisor on
the Department of Education's efforts to counter
antisemitic discrimination at covered institutions;

17 providing information to students at covered institu18 tions about how to file complaints of discrimination

(3) remind covered institutions of their legal responsibility under title VI of the Civil Rights Act of
1964 (42 U.S.C. 2000d et seq.) to provide all students, including those who are or are perceived to be
Jewish or Israeli, a school environment free from
discrimination based on race, color, or national ori-

gin, including shared ancestry or ethnic characteris tics;

23 (including shared ancestry or ethnic character24 istics) at a covered institution; and
