2 SEC. 6. REPORTS ON THE IMPACTS OF PRESIDENTIAL EX-

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ECUTIVE ORDERS ON OCR'S FUNCTIONS.

Beginning not later than 30 days after the date of
enactment of this Act and ending 1 year after the date
of enactment of this Act, the Assistant Secretary for Civil
Rights of the Department of Education shall provide to
the Committee on Health, Education, Labor and Pensions

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and the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate and 1 the Committee on Education and Workforce and the Com-2 mittee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives 3 a quarterly report on the impact of Executive orders and 4 directives from the Office of Management and Budget on 5 the case processing of the Office for Civil Rights of the 6 Department of Education (referred to in this section as 7 "OCR"), including at a minimum, the following data, as 8 of the date of the report: 9

10 (1) Data on the number of staff members re-11 tained by each OCR office.

12 (2) Data on the average number of cases as-13 signed to each OCR investigator.

14 (3) Data on the number and type of OCR eases15 opened and closed.

16 (4) Data on the average case processing17 timelines for OCR cases.
