5 (1) ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT PERCENTAGE.—The 6 term "annual adjustment percentage", with respect 7 to appropriations made under this section for a fis-8 cal year, means a percentage equal to the estimated 9 percentage change in the Consumer Price Index, as BOM25273 X2Y

determined by the Secretary of Education, for the
 most recent calendar year ending prior to the begin ning of such fiscal year.

4 (2) CONSUMER PRICE INDEX.—The term "Con5 sumer Price Index" has the meaning given the term
6 in section 478(f) of the Higher Education Act of
7 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1087rr(f)).

8 (b) IN GENERAL.—In addition to amounts otherwise 9 made available, there is appropriated, out of any money 10 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for expenses 11 necessary for the Office for Civil Rights of the Department 12 of Education, as established under section 203 of the De-13 partment of Education Organization Act (20 U.S.C. 14 3413)—

15 (1) for fiscal year 2025, \$140,000,000; and

(2) for each succeeding fiscal year, the amount
appropriated under this section for the preceding fiscal year, increased by the annual adjustment percentage.

(c) AVAILABILITY.—Amounts made available under
this section for a fiscal year shall remain available for the
2 succeeding fiscal years.
