(a) STAFFING LEVELS.—In carrying out the requirements described in section 203(c)(2) of the Department
of Education Organization Act (20 U.S.C. 3413(c)(2)) to
select, appoint, and employ officers and employees of the

Office for Civil Rights of the Department of Education,
 including staff attorneys, the Department of Education
 shall—

4 (1) employ not less than the same number of

9 (2) ensure such staff increase the capacity of

(b) CASELOADS.—Not more than 15 days after the date of enactment of this Act and in each succeeding fiscal year, the Assistant Secretary for Civil Rights of the Department of Education shall take all necessary steps to ensure that caseloads managed by full-time equivalent staff attorneys at such Office do not exceed the staff to case ratios from fiscal year 2024.
