## THE HEAD START PROGRAM.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Federal funds may be appropriated or transferred to, or used
by, the Secretary of Health and Human Services to facilitate the elimination of the Head Start program (including
the Early Head Start program) under the Head Start Act
(42 U.S.C. 9831 et seq.).

## 1 SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. RESTORING EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT 2 OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 15 days after the 3 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and 4 Human Services shall take all necessary steps to restore 5 the number of full-time equivalent employees employed at 6 the Office of Head Start, including regional offices, of the 7 Administration for Children and Families of the Depart-8 ment of Health and Human Services to the number of 9 such employees that were employed at such Office of Head 10Start on January 20, 2025. 11

(b) Administrative Leave.—The Secretary of 12 Health and Human Services shall ensure that each em-13 ployee of the Office of Head Start, including regional of-14 fices, that was placed on administrative leave not earlier 15 than January 20, 2025 and not later than the date of en-16 actment of this Act shall be fully restored to that employ-17 18 ee's position in the Office of Head Start, so that the employee may carry out the employee's full job responsibil-19 20 ities on behalf of the people of the United States.
