4 (a) APPEARANCE OF HEAD OF DOGE AND SPECIAL 5 ADVISORS REQUIRED.—Not later than 15 days after the 6 date of enactment of this Act, and quarterly thereafter 7 in accordance with the requirements of subsection (b), the 8 head of the United States DOGE Service (referred to in 9 this section as "DOGE") and each special Government 10 employee serving as a Senior Advisor to the President ROM25257 2N7

whose duties include advising the President on the oper ations of the DOGE shall jointly provide a briefing before
 the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pen sions of the Senate, and a briefing before the Committee
 on Education and Workforce of the House of Representa tives, to present information on—

(1) as of the date of the briefing and for the 7 period covered by the briefing, the activities carried 8 out by the DOGE that affect matters under the ju-9 risdiction of each such committee (as described in 10 rule XXV of the Standing Rules of the Senate and 11 rule X of the Rules of the House of Representatives, 12 respectively), including matters relating to the Office 13 for Civil Rights of the Department of Education; 14 15 and

16 (2) any activities described in paragraph (1)
17 that the DOGE intends to carry out after the date
18 of such briefing.

(b) FREQUENCY AND DURATION.—The head of the
DOGE and each special Government employee described
in subsection (a) shall jointly provide the briefings described in such subsection not less than once a quarter
following the date of the initial briefings until January 20,
2029.
