2	SEC PUBLICATION OF LIST OF HOSPITALS.	
3	(a) List of Hospitals.—Beginning not later than	
4	90 days after the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-	
5	retary of Health and Human Services (referred to in this	
6	section as the "Secretary") shall establish and maintain	
7	a publicly available list, on the website of the Centers for	
8	Medicare & Medicaid Services, of each hospital that—	
9	(1) is not in compliance with the hospital price	
10	transparency rule implementing section 2718(e) of	
11	the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg-	

1	18(e)), and that, with respect to such noncompli-
2	ance—
3	(A) has been issued a civil monetary pen-
4	alty;
5	(B) has received a warning notice; or
6	(C) has received a request for a corrective
7	action plan; or
8	(2) has received any written communication by
9	the Secretary regarding potential noncompliance
10	with such hospital price transparency rule.
11	(b) FOIA REQUESTS.—Any penalty, notice, request,
12	or other communication described in subsection (a) shall
13	be subject to public disclosure, in full and without redac-
14	tion, under section 552 of title 5, United States Code, not-
15	withstanding any exemptions or exclusions otherwise avail-
16	able under such section 552.
17	(c) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 1 year
18	after the date of enactment of this Act and each year
19	thereafter, the Secretary shall submit to Congress, and
20	make publicly available, a report that contains information
21	regarding complaints of alleged violations of law and en-
22	forcement activities by the Secretary under the hospital
23	price transparency rule implementing section 2718(e) of
24	the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300gg-18(e)).

- 3 (d) GAO REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the
- 4 date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General

- 7 the Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee
- 8 on Energy and Commerce of the House of Representatives
- 9 a report on the compliance and enforcement with the hos-
