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"(i) REPORTS AND EVALUATION.-

2 "(1) ELIGIBLE ENTITIES.—An eligible entity awarded a grant this section shall submit interim re-3 4 ports to the Secretary on the activities carried out 5 through a project supported by the grant and a final report on such activities upon the conclusion of the 6 7 participation of the entity in the project. Such reports shall include assessments of the effectiveness 8 9 of such activities with respect to improving the outcome of expanding the number of family nurse prac-10 11 titioner training programs in the areas in which the 12 grant is provided.

13 "(2) EVALUATION.—The Secretary shall, by 14 grant, contract, or interagency agreement, evaluate on an interim basis the grants awarded under this 15 section. Such evaluation shall include identification 16 17 of successful activities for creating opportunities for developing and sustaining growth in the number of 18 19 family nurse practitioner training programs that meet high standards for education, training, certifi-20 21 cation, and professional development, and that are 22 responsive to the nursing practitioner shortage.

23 "(3) ANNUAL REPORTS.—Not later than Octo24 ber 1 of each of fiscal years 2025 through 2027, the
25 Secretary shall submit, to the Committee on Health,
