2 **SEC. 6. PROHIBITION ON TRANSFERRING THE FUNCTIONS**  
3 **OF THE OFFICE OF SPECIAL EDUCATION AND**  
4 **REHABILITATIVE SERVICES TO OTHER FED-**  
5 **ERAL AGENCIES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
7 sion of law and subject to subsection (c), the Secretary  
8 of Education shall not procure services from, contract or  
9 carry out an agreement with, obtain any goods or services  
10 from, transfer activities to, or enter into a similar arrange-  
11 ment with, another Federal agency relating to the func-

1 tions of the Department of Education's Office of Special  
2 Education and Rehabilitative Services authorized under  
3 section 207 of the Department of Education Organization  
4 Act (20 U.S.C. 3417).

5 (b) APPLICABILITY OF OTHER LAWS.—Subject to  
6 subsection (c), section 430(a) of the General Education  
7 Provisions Act (20 U.S.C. 1231(a)), section 415 and 419  
8 of the Department of Education Organization Act (20  
9 U.S.C. 3475, 3479), and section 1535 of title 31, United  
10 States Code (commonly known as the "Economy Act")  
11 shall not apply to section 207 of the Department of Edu-  
12 cation Organization Act (20 U.S.C. 3417).

13 (c) EXCEPTION.—This section shall not apply to—

14 (1) any procurement, contract, agreement (in-  
15 cluding an agreement for obtaining goods or serv-  
16 ices), transfer, or similar arrangement, between the  
17 Department of Education and another Federal agen-  
18 cy that was in effect on February 1, 2025; and

19 (2) the renewal of such a procurement, con-  
20 tract, agreement, transfer, or similar arrangement  
21 described in this subsection.
