AMENDMENT intended to be proposed by Mr. MURPHY

Viz:

- 1 At the end, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. PROHIBITION ON TRANSFER OF INFORMATION.**
- 3 Section 445 of the General Education Provisions Act
- 4 (20 U.S.C. 1232h), is amended—
- 5 (1) by redesignating subsections (d) through (f)
- 6 as subsections (e) through (g), respectively; and
- 7 (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-
- 8 lowing:

1       “(d) PROHIBITION ON TRANSFER OF INFORMA-  
2 TION.—An institution of higher education (as defined in  
3 section 102 of the Higher Education Act of 1965) may  
4 not give information to the Department of State or the  
5 Department of Homeland Security for purposes of immi-  
6 gration enforcement solely due to an alien’s past, current,  
7 or expected beliefs, statements, or associations, if such be-  
8 liefs, statements, or associations would be lawful within  
9 the United States.”.
