- 2        “(5) In the case that the Secretary receives a notification under paragraph (2)(A), the Secretary shall—
- 3                “(A) exercise enforcement discretion with respect to infant formula, including with respect to the importation of infant formula, until corrective actions with respect to the infant formula that was the subject of such notification have been completed;
